Judging Criteria

Thank you for agreeing to serve as a judge for this year's Research Day. The major goal of this event is to support the development of DVM and graduate students by inviting them to experience giving oral presentations in a meeting format. By **asking them questions after their presentations**, you provide a major part of this experience.

In addition, we ask that you provide **numerical scores** for each presentation. Below are 10 categories, with potential scores ranging from 1 to 10, totalling up to 100 points.

Please use the following scale when applying scores:

- **9 to 10 points should be for truly exceptional mastery of a category (there should be very few of these);**
- **6 to 8 points should be for effective mastery of a category that you consider to be good to very good;**
- **3 to 5 points should be for a category that is good but, should be scored lower than good to very good;**
- **Below 3 points should be for a category that was not ready for presentation (there should be very few of these).**
