

2019-2020 Radiology Residency Application Cycle

University of Tennessee College of Veterinary Medicine

The UTCVM offers a four year structured program designed to prepare the resident to qualify for and pass the certifying examination in diagnostic radiology of the American College of Veterinary Radiology (<https://www.acvr.org/>). An advanced degree program is not offered in conjunction with the residency.

One residency position is offered per year, which is filled through the Veterinary Internship & Residency Matching Program (<https://www.virmp.org/>). We are unable to accept additional externally funded residents.

For 2019-20, up to 20 slots are available for on-site group interviews. Up to 4 individuals applicants will be scheduled for a given day. Interview dates are:

- Friday 10/18/19
- Friday 11/8/19
- Friday 11/22/19
- Tuesday 12/10/19
- Monday 1/13/20

On interview dates, candidates will be asked to arrive at the Veterinary Medical Center at 8 or 9 a.m. Interviews usually wrap up around 3 p.m.

Additionally, up to 20 phone interviews may be scheduled. Skype interviews will not be offered.

All interview slots are filled on a first-come-first-serve basis and tend to fill up quickly. Any candidate interested in arranging an interview is asked to contact the residency program director (Silke Hecht; shecht@utk.edu) and provide the following:

- Preference for interview (visit or phone)
- Available dates
 - From list above for visit
 - 5-10 available dates/times for phone interview. Note that no phone interviews will be scheduled 11/25-12/6.
- Current CV including GPA/class rank and names of references
