



Canvas gradebook can do it for y

- ▶ Can weight grades for quizzes and exams
- ▶ Grading rubrics are magical
 - ▶ These can be hidden or revealed to the student
 - ▶ If you hide the grades (like we do in necropsy) make sure you place a copy of the rubric in the materials that students can access
- ▶ You can define your own grading schemes
 - ▶ Final grades displayed in percentages and the corresponding final letter grade
- ▶ Grading schemes / rubrics can be created once and applied to multiple courses



Building easy to grade content


- ▶ Content is organized into assignment “groups”
 - ▶ These groups can then be assigned a percentage of the total grade
 - ▶ 80% pathologist grading
 - ▶ 5% pre quiz
 - ▶ 15% post quiz
- ▶ Tests / quizzes
 - ▶ These are constructed as normal
 - ▶ Added to the appropriate assignment group for weighted grading
- ▶ Grading rubrics
 - ▶ These are “no submission assignments” meaning the student does not submit anything for this (probably doesn’t even know it exists)
