Do you have any patients that could lose a few pounds?

The UTCVM Veterinary Obesity Center and Royal Canin are working together to improve the health and wellbeing of pets by treating obesity. For patients that are overweight, they are offering a *FREE:

1. Initial in person evaluation by a UTCVM nutritionist
2. Blood and urine testing for routine health screening
3. A Dual Energy X-ray Absorptiometry (DXA) screening to measure body fat and lean mass

Follow up weigh-in sessions (~ 30 minutes each) are also included at no charge to the owner.

1. First session will be 2 weeks after starting the diet plan
2. And every 4 weeks thereafter until the patient has reached their goal weight
3. Then every 2-4 weeks until their weight is stable

Additional information

1. The referring veterinarian must complete a nutrition referral form
2. Initial consultation with the Veterinary Obesity Center is not available remotely and patients must be able to be seen in person.
3. Patients should not have comorbidities that prevent feeding a weight loss diet. Please reach out if you have questions about whether or not a patient will qualify.
4. While consultation with a rehabilitation specialist can be considered, any costs associated with this are not covered by the Veterinary Obesity Center.

*Testing or procedures that do not fall into our standard protocol may incur additional costs.
